KING'S CORONATION set a clear pace, opened a long lead on the final turn and was never threatened while kept to a drive. A NICE SPLASH steadied along nearing the quarter pole then closed well when clear in the final furlong. RECTORY HILL outrun early, rallied wide and closed well through the stretch. EMERALTAU raced three wide, move closer into the stretch then flattened out. SABRE BABY raced far behind and never menaced. OWN STYLE raced wide and was never a factor. PRAIRIE LITES within striking range between rivals, lacked a rally. CREVE COEUR raced close up to the final turn then weakened. BLAZING GLORY was always outrun. CALL THE MARINES moved close up inside for half a mile then faltered. AVENTUROUS SWORD prompted the pace to the final turn then stopped abruptly. BAVARIAN BARON was far back throughout.
