JUDIANE'S JUBILEE angled over to save ground early while settling well back, started her advance after a half mile, entered the stretch four wide, was urged to the lead near the sixteenth pole and drew clear toward the wire. REPELLER settled off the pace about the three path, started a drive into the final turn, dueled to the lead in the upper stretch, was briefly clear past the furlong pole then outfinished from the sixteenth. LILY LUNA stalked the pace three wide the opening turn, made her bid saving ground approaching the final turn and ran evenly in the lane. AVE RAVINA, off the pace off the rail, lost some ground through the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. OLD GREY SQUARE stalked the early pace two deep, picked up the chase past the half mile pole then faded on the final turn. TEREVAKA was outrun and five wide entering the stretch. DO SO rated a clear lead inside, was pressured into the lane and dueled close to midstretch before giving way. AMAUNET was not a factor.
