ARMED AND READY steadied in tight racing into the first turn, saved ground, swung very wide and rallied. SHOOTING FIRE raced outside and just off the pace, had no rally. SNAR BUNNY saved ground, changed course in mid stretch. SOLITARY SAGA steadied in tight racing into first turn. NOBLE AFFAIR just off the early pace, tired. ONAMMISSIONFROMGOD failed to menace. IT WAS INEVITABLE vied for command two wide, tired. LOLLY'S LEGACY failed to menace. COSTLY COUNTESS lost her rider leaving the gate.
