HOLDMEDADDY raced off the pace three wide early, made a menacing bid into the stretch then edged clear in the final furlong. BARELY SOVEREIGN rushed up to the front then moved inside, resisted when challenged on the final turn and gave way grudgingly. DAMARISCOTTA engaged the pacesetter outside on the final turn and battled gamely to the finish. MARIA'S MOJO was outrun early, raced outside and rallied mildly. MARGE'S BID raced outside and never threatened. BO'S A TEN within striking range early, gradually retreated. BANDY raced far back for three quarters and passed fading rivals. SUGARTOWN ROSE raced inside and never menaced. ESPIGA prompted the pace inside then was finished by the final turn.
