Footnotes

ALL THE FIGS MEN moved easily while wide on the turn then drew away when ready in the final furlong. R. BEE ESS slipped through inside to duel on the turn, led briefly in the stretch but was outfinished. UNCLE ELI dropped back early, moved wide on the turn then closed near the inside in the stretch. STEALING SARATOGA held a narrow lead outside for half a mile and continued well to the finish. ANNEX FEED broke sluggishly, advanced outside and never menaced. TOUCHED BY A STAR dropped far back then passed fading rivals. QUICK QUEST was far back then very wide on the turn and was never a factor. GHOST STORY prompted the pace for half a mile then faltered. SHOW LOW saved ground throughout and faded. JOYSTICK forced the pace between rivals to the turn then stopped.
