RY'S NOT SHY prompted the pace four wide, edged to the front on the turn then held rivals safe in the final furlong. ELECTOR awaited room between rivals near the far turn, split foes rallying into the lane and was up for the place. FUERTE trailed early, rallied extremely wide and gained too late. NIFTY MAMBO made a menacing five wide advance on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. BLAZING TAURUS vied for the advantage near the inside then weakened in the stretch. G'DAY MATE was blocked behind a wall of runners in the opening quarter then faded when clear. EL TAJIN saved ground while close up to the stretch then faltered. GERRITSEN held a brief lead outside in the opening quarter then began retreating on the turn.
