GRIZZLY GIRL was outrun early, slipped through inside rallying in the stretch and quickly drew off. LUCKYHEARTED stalked the pace outside, loomed boldly in the stretch but was outfinished in the final furlong. SONIA'S MUNCHKIN set the pace inside to midstretch then gave way. HOME BY NINE forced the pace outside, mover closer at the quarter pole then weakened. MONIKER raced wide and was always outrun. MANSION was carried out and bumped near the far turn, raced wide and was no factor. SENSATIONAL DIVA raced off the pace and gradually retreated. REBEL ROUSER raced very wide and gave way readily.
