DESERT PARTY was sluggish at the start, moved up quickly in the two path, was blocked and awaited room in traffic losing position to the quarter pole, angled out, reached the front nearing the eighth pole then drew off eagerly and was taken in hand in the closing yards. UNCLE GIDGE prompted the pace outside under rating, bid to the front on the turn, was overtaken near mid-stretch but continued well in a game try. MANNINGTON was allowed to relax while very wide, made a brief menacing move near the far turn but lacked a further response. RILEY TUCKER raced close up in the three path then gradually weakened while just missing the show award. CHEROKEE COUNTRY was angled to the inside early, moved closer on the turn then tired down the stretch. STRASBOURG set a clear pace for a quarter mile, was challenged on the turn and faltered.
