**Footnotes**

FORTISSI MORE rated off the pace outside, started his drive six wide into the final turn, drifted inward through the stretch while gaining control past the eighth pole then drew clear the closing yards. HIGHLAND CAT rated just off the pace, started his bid five wide into the final turn, briefly lacked room leaving the quarter pole, came between horses to duel inside from the top of the stretch, steadied passing the chute gap and leveled off from there. SUNSHINEINTHERAIN rated back toward mid track, bid into the final turn, eased outside the drifting Fortissi More nearing the eighth pole and finished strong. BRAVE TIGER rated close three wide, moved to even terms approaching the final turn, dug in with a slim advantage on the turn then leveled off in the stretch. DR. SMARTY JACK rated off the pace about the four path, was boxed in approaching the final turn, started a drive near the five sixteenths pole, checked sharply at the heels of Partner George in midstretch and finished strong when clear. BROTHER SY rated off the pace while settling at the flanks of Reflected Way on the backstretch, came around that one while advancing toward the final turn, was within range of the lead in the upper stretch but weakened from there. MOVING VIOLATION settled back inside then had a mild stretch bid. VOODOO'S RUN, unhurried, bid mildly on the final turn. LIE IN THE SAND was jostled into then steadied between horses through the first turn, rated off the pace off the rail then faded on the final turn. PARTNER GEORGE was brushed lightly into the first turn, rated a slim lead about the three path, saved ground contesting the final turn then gave way in the stretch. REFLECTED WAY, brushed early, rated close inside the opening half mile then gave way. After reviewing a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, the stewards disqualified the winner from first and placed him second for drifting in on the runner up in late stretch.
