Footnotes

SWEET DAHLIA, a step slow to break, was boxed in three wide the opening turn and most of the backstretch, made a bid forcing her way out leaving the final turn, came to the front just inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear toward the wire. KISSAMEE GLITTER, a step slow to break, came through the opening turn four wide, settled off the pace down the backstretch, eased five wide making her bid into the stretch and closed steadily to get place just under the wire. PROFIT, off the pace about the three path the opening turn, bid toward contention through the backstretch, was carried out leaving the final turn and closed well to deep stretch though outfinished for place just under the wire. SURE CLASS stalked the pace two deep, kept aim through the final turn and closed to the sixteenth pole before leveling off. WINGS OF A DOVE rated off the pace inside, was boxed and roughed at the heels of the waning Dr. Jess Jr nearing the five sixteenths pole and finished well when clear. ADELICATE MISS rated a short lead inside, was pressured toward the quarter pole and dug in with the advantage to the sixteenth pole before weakening. MISS FLEETFOOT, broke in, rated back off the rail, eased out entering the stretch and leveled off the remainder. DR. JESS JR rated close inside then steadied while weakening near the five sixteenths pole. RIVETING, pinched back early, was not a factor.
