Footnotes

DIAMONDBREAKER rated back toward mid track, improved her position while four wide on the turn, advanced to even terms a sixteenth away then edged ahead late under mostly a hand ride. GOODMAN'S GIRL stalked the early pace two deep, edged clear toward the turn, was pressured into the lane, dug in from the sixteenth pole but reluctantly yielded approaching the wire. RUN AURORA RUN chased the pace inside then leveled off in the stretch. JULIE'S BRONZIE dropped well back saving ground, bid approaching the quarter pole and finished well inside. PURE VISION showed no speed outside and finished evenly. QUEEN'S KISS steadied early and had no rally outside. MY MANHATTAN set the early pace inside then faded from the three eighths pole. TEA JAY SEA bobbled at the start, picked up the chase toward mid track, had aim on the turn then weakened in the stretch. YOUNG QUEEN chased the pace inside and gave way on the turn.
