Footnotes

VERY ARROGANT was allowed to settle while trailing for half a mile, rallied four wide on the final turn and was up after a long drive. RATHOR (IRE) was restrained off the pace for half a mile, earned a brief lead on the final turn then held on gamely when challenged in the stretch. DEVIL APPROVED IT raced very wide off the pace, advanced on the final turn then faded. DEMPSEY set slow fractions early but faded when challenged on the final turn. LEGACY RESERVE broke alertly and raced close up inside and was finished after half a mile. BULLET RAIN raced in the two path within striking range for a half mile then stopped. MR. MURPHY prompted the pace briefly then gave way readily.
