Footnotes

JILL THE PILL moved to the lead approaching the wire the first time, saved ground into the opening turn, rated the pace through the backstretch, dug in determinedly in a tight duel from the top of the lane and lasted well with steady encouragement. REPELLER settled off the pace off the rail, started her drive into the final turn, entered the stretch four wide though was outfinished in a close duel from the eighth pole. DYNAKRALL stalked the pace off the rail, started a drive approaching the five sixteenths pole and dueled close in the upper stretch before reluctantly yielding the final sixteenth. SNOOZE, unhurried about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole and finished well while too late. EQUISIZE rated back two deep, bid while between horses through the final turn then leveled off from the eighth pole. OLD GREY SQUARE, unhurried off the rail, angled five wide near the quarter pole and finished evenly toward the outside. TEREVAKA, off the pace about the four path, bid from the three eighths pole, entered the stretch six wide and weakened from there. LUCY QUATORZE settled off the pace inside, bid into the final turn, was boxed at the rail past the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. LILY LUNA was outrun while saving ground.
