CATCH ME FIRST stalked the pace in the two path, collared the leader in the stretch and prevailed in a stretch-long duel. FLEETWAY set the pace inside, resisted when challenged in a game effort. A KING'S SMILE was outrun early, split rivals rallying on the final turn and was too late. HEDONISM angled inside on the backstretch and was outfinished late. PROFESSOR MAXWELL raced far back early and finished with good energy inside late. VOICE OF POWER dueled the leader in the two path and came up empty in the stretch. KELTIC DANCER within striking range in the two path, came up empty. RUDY S was never a threat. MOVE WEST broke sluggishly, raced outside and never threatened. CLICK HERE was never in contention. DISORDERLY CONDUCT raced close up early inside and stopped abruptly. JOHNNY MAC was always outrun.
