Footnotes

BLUE LIGHT SPECIAL raced well reserved to stalk the pace two deep, moved alongside the pacesetter into the final turn, dueled to the lead past the five sixteenths pole and dug in from the head of the lane to edge clear and widen beyond the eighth pole. MUSKWA, unhurried inside, eased out making a bid into the final turn, altered course to the outside a furlong away and closed well for place. BERT'S TOO KINKY rated close about the three path, bid past the three eighths pole, briefly acquired place inside the sixteenth pole but was outfinished for that position nearing the wire. PONT DES SOUPIRS raced clear for position inside approaching the first turn, rated his speed to the three eighths pole, contested the rail on the final turn and remained a close factor to midstretch before weakening. FOREST KING rated off the pace inside, lacked sufficient response from the three eighths pole and leveled off with a furlong to go.
