Footnotes

SILVER KING, two deep the opening turn, rated close through the backstretch, contested the final turn off the rail, dueled with the edge in the upper stretch, was briefly clear toward the wire and held well with steady encouragement. BROTHER SY, unhurried about the four path, inched forward through the backstretch, entered the stretch five wide and closed steadily for place in a strong finish. SANDBAGIN' LOVER, shuffled back at the rail near the three quarter pole, rated close inside, was pressured for run toward the final turn, eased three wide through the lane and though unfinished for place, finished well. RY'S NOT SHY, three wide into the first turn, rated the pace inside through the backstretch, contested the rail on the final turn then reluctantly yielded inside the eighth pole. POCKET PATCH rated off the pace about the three path, gave chase through the final turn, closed to deep stretch though was shuffled back nearing the wire. SACO RIVER showed no speed toward the outside, bid widest near the quarter pole and finished well. TEJANOS ELIMINATOR, unhurried inside, made a mild bid into the stretch. PINE HAWK was shuffled back on the first turn, settled well back about the four path and had no rally. MOVIN' OUT was shuffled back into the first turn, pinched back past the three quarter pole, boxed in through most of the backstretch and showed no response on the final turn.
