PLEASE BE QUIET broke alertly to set the pace, repulsed a challenge on the turn then edged away again. NICKEL C was outrun early outside then made a gradual gain through the stretch. ALUMINUM DIGGER moved outside the pacesetter early, engaged the leader on the turn then weakened. RACING DEE was unruly delaying the start, broke sluggishly and was no factor. PRINCESS TERMS saved ground and was always outrun. DIAMONDSNGOLDRUSH was injured at the starting gate and was ordered a late scratch by the track veterinarian.
