**Footnotes**

TALE OF THE DIVA stalked the pace about the three path on the backstretch, started her drive into the final turn, raced between horses from the five sixteenths pole, dug in from the top of the lane and edged ahead through the final sixteenth. MYSTERIOUS MARISSA rated off the pace about the four path, moved to a slim lead three wide past the five sixteenths pole and dug in with the advantage to deep stretch before reluctantly ceding. TIFFANY ROCK rated a clear pace inside through the backstretch, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole but weakened in the lane. SHEZOUTAHERE bobbled a stride from the gate, chased the pace toward mid track and proved empty in the stretch. DROP THE MAIL showed no speed off the rail then no response on the final turn. LITTLE NANCY was not a factor. SO SO DIVINE raced no factor toward the outside and was vanned off post race.
