FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination, \$750 to pass the entry box, \$1,250 additional to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed by Philadelphia Park and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Breeders' Cup eligibles only. The \$200,000 guaranteed by Philadelphia Park to be divided: \$120,000 to the winner with \$40,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weights: Three year olds 117 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of an unrestricted stakes at mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010, 5 lbs.; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2010, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming or starter races not considered). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Tuesday, July 13, 2010.

Nominations closed Saturday, July 3, 2010 with 11. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

Footnotes

A. U. MINER settled well back off the rail, started his drive toward the outside leaving the three eighths pole then steadily closed ground to reach the lead in the final strides. ALCOMO (BRZ) rated back about the four path, started his advance after the opening mile, was at even terms three wide near the quarter pole, dueled determinedly to a slim advantage in the upper stretch, was briefly clear then outfinished the final strides. JADE'S REVENGE stalked the pace about the four path, bid toward the three eighths pole, was at even terms while between horses a quarter mile away, had a slim brief lead at the top of the lane then leveled off inside the eighth pole. GABRIEL'S HILL rated the pace inside the opening mile, was pressured beyond the half mile pole, contested the rail through the final turn and remained a close factor to midstretch before beginning to yield. STONES RIVER rated back inside, bid toward the rail approaching the three eighths pole, angled out past the five sixteenths then came back in while leveling off from the upper stretch. MARILYN'S GUY settled well back outside for three quarters, advanced toward contention nearing the final turn, showed no response through the turn and was not encouraged further.
