SAMANTHA G was reserved early inside, was blocked and steadied on the final turn then drew away under mild coaxing. LADY MUTADDA edged to a narrow lead before a half, held a clear into the stretch but was no match for the winner. SWEET GIANNA set a clear pace inside, battled when challenged then came again and just missed the place. PECAN TASSIE dropped back early, advanced wide on the final turn then flattened out in the stretch. MIDDLETOWN MAGIC raced far behind, moved very wide into the stretch and was no factor. NO BLUSHING broke in at the start, prompted four wide then lugged in when tiring in the stretch. MARY'S DANCER was bothered between rivals at the start and raced far back. ARROW LAKE broke out at the start, forced the pace three wide then was finished before three quarters.
