JACKIE'S EXPRESS chased the pace about the four path on the turn, dueled for control nearing the eighth pole and drew off under steady encouragement from there. LIL PRECIOUS was hustled to the lead for position just off the rail to set the pace, dueled from the head of the lane but yielded to the winner past the eighth pole. SWEET AS YOU ARE chased the pace toward mid track and finished evenly. FEAR THE LION chased the early pace from the outside, saved some ground through the turn then leveled off in the lane. BROKEN FEVER chased the early pace from the outside then had nothing further in the lane. ROLEX GIRL chased the pace from the inside and faded through the lane. KNOCK OUT ROSEY never factored.
