### Footnotes

ZORRO'S PRIDE came away from a sharp start to quickly take command off the rail, was rated to the top of the lane then widened the final furlong under steady handling. SINATRA'S DANCER chased the pace inside and finished well to be second best while no threat to the winner. TRAIN DERAILMENT chased the pace about the three path, held aim through the turn then leveled off in the stretch. COTTON GEORGE chased the pace about the four path before fading in the lane. YOUR LUCKY DAY showed no speed while saving ground. RED BIRD SOLDIER was not a factor.
