Footnotes

KISSAMEE GLITTER rated close to the pace inside, was hemmed at the rail through the final turn, started her bid entering the stretch and reached the lead the closing yards in a well timed drive. SWEET DAHLIA rated off the pace too deep, waited while boxed off the rail through the final turn, bid angling inward at the top of the stretch and finished well while too late to catch the winner. SLEWIE JONES rated back about the three path, improved her position five wide on the final turn, finished well and closed steadily for show. SURE CLASS rated the pace inside, was pressured for run entering the stretch and maintained the advantage to the sixteenth pole before beginning to weaken. RIVETING, hemmed in leaving the first turn, settled back inside through the backstretch, lacked room at the top of the lane and had no rally. DR. JESS JR stalked the pace two deep before weakening from the head of the lane. WINGS OF A DOVE was not a factor. CALAMARI rated off the pace about the three path, made a mild four wide bid on the final turn then gave way in the lane.
