SUZZONA was eased back between rivals in the first quarter, bid three wide into the stretch and edged away in the final furlong. QUEBRADA SHINER (ARG) outrun early while saving ground, split rivals rallying into the stretch but was too late. TRY AND CATCH ME raced inside off the pace, angled out advancing into the lane then weakened. TWICEASBEAUTIFUL vied for the advantage outside, led on the turn then faltered. SANDI'S READY raced outside and lacked a rally. INDYCAT vied inside while leading to the far turn then gradually weakened. BANK'N ON GOLD raced in the two path and was never a factor. FASTONGRASS trailed throughout while saving ground.
