COOLVILLE, quickly in front, set a pressured pace off the rail, lost ground leaving the quarter pole then widened gradually while drifting out through the stretch. TIMELY COMMAND pressured the pace two deep, lost some ground leaving the quarter pole then proved second best while no match for the winner. GIANNA'S PRINCESS, shuffled back at the start, steadily accelerated toward contention on the backstretch and finished well considering her earlier deficit. SIGONELLA showed no speed toward mid track, saved ground through the turn and finished evenly inside. EVIL JUDGEMENT chased the pace toward mid track, was shuffled back leaving the quarter pole then leveled off outside. HAWTY CREEK passed some tiring rivals. GIANT CANAL chased the early pace from the outside and weakened through the lane. IN QUAGA'S HONOR chased the pace about the four path and gave way. HOPE SECURES chased the pace inside and tired from the turn. TEK ON TWO saved ground while not a factor.
