FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS & UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination, \$250 to pass the entry box, \$500 additional to start. With \$100,000 guaranteed by Philadelphia Park and an additional \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Breeders' Cup eligibles only. The \$100,000 guaranteed by Philadelphia Park to be divided-60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund.

LOADED GUN dueled for command outside rivals, shook loose when put to steady right handed pressure and held a clear lead in mid stretch and then was under strong handling to the wire. ARTAX broke very slowly, recovered quickly and was sent up to challenge while saving ground, fell back leaving the turn but then was coming back at the winner. POWER BY FAR vied for command inside, also fell back slightly in mid stretch and was coming back. PAL JOEY between foes early, was eased back slightly on the far turn, swung wide, challenged in mid stretch but then hung. CRUCIBLE raced wide and just off the pace and tired. SAY FLORIDA SANDY, wide, failed to menace. WIRE ME COLLECT failed to threaten. MASTER O FOXHOUNDS, between foes and just off the pace, tired. COPELAN'S NUMBER, wide, failed to menace.
