SO EXPLOSIVE rated back from the lengthy lead of the pacesetter in the three path, quickly closed ground on the final turn, took over past the quarter pole, exchanged light contact with Power Bid at the top of the lane and dug in determinedly, under strong handling, to last. POWER BID rated back off the rail, closed for the lead just inside the five sixteenths pole, exchanged light contact with So Explosive at the top of the stretch, remained at that one's withers throughout the drive, and while outfinished for the win, held on for place. MISS MOCKINGBIRD, unhurried off the rail, started a drive past the three eighths pole, eased out entering the lane, was closing steadily and finished well. ALMOST GRECIAN showed no speed well back inside and bid mildly on the final turn. EASTER BONUS raced outside and never factored. BOSS'S RULES ran out the first turn and displayed a tendency to drift out. LONGING FOR LORI was through early. INDIAN LEGEND drew off to a long early lead, was overcome past the five sixteenths pole and readily gave way from there.
