STACY'S FAVORITE sprinted clear inside, increased her margin on the final turn then just lasted. BENNINGTON was outrun early, angled out and rallied strongly in the stretch to just miss. COZY REPORTER stalked the pace inside, loomed boldly in the stretch but was outfinished. CLEVER TO ME raced far back early racing inside then closed a gap without threatening. LITTLE POLISH WOLF raced far behind for half a mile then rallied too late. HOLDMEDADDY raced very wide and never menaced. TOAST TO THE LADY was never a factor. RINGOFDIAMONDS fanned very wide on the first turn, remained wide and was outrun. MISS WHIRLYBIRD raced just off the pace between rivals and stopped abruptly. LUNA LA ESTRELLAS forced the pace outside for half a mile then gave way readily.
