ROSALITA'S WISH settled well back toward the rail, advanced through the final turn in the three path and continued her steady progression under a hard drive to get up the closing yards. MILK AND HONEY rated a short lead inside, was pressured at the rail through the final turn, recovered clear ground in midstretch then outfinished the closing yards. EASTER SERVICE showed no early speed inside, bid toward the rail at the three eighths pole and finished well. THE AMATEUR stalked the pace two deep, moved to threaten nearing the quarter pole but lacked further in the stretch. DYNAKRALL rated off the pace off the rail and had no rally. LUCY QUATORZE rated off the pace inside, started a drive into the final turn then weakened in the stretch. STONY BROOK SLEW and OLD GREY SQUARE were not factors.
