SERENE QUEEN outrun early, circled her field rallying on the final turn, reached the front in early stretch, drove clear then was taken under wraps late. SHEZOUTAHERE made a menacing three wide bid on the final turn, led briefly into the stretch but was no match for the winner. AMERICAN BREW dropped far behind early outside, moved extremely wide into the stretch and made a mild bid. WAIMEA BAY prompted the pace three wide for three quarters then faltered. BARBIE GIRL set a pressured pace inside, moved clear on the final turn then came up empty in the stretch. LITTLE NANCY moved up in the two path to engage the leader after a quarter mile then gave way after five furlongs. SPRIGHTLY POLISH saved ground and faded badly.
