Footnotes

ELIXIR reserved just off the pace, split rivals rallying on the turn, moved inside in the stretch and edged ahead. NOT UP FOR LOVE made a menacing four wide move on the turn, loomed boldly in the stretch but was outfinished. DEGRAFF outrun early, advanced five wide on the turn then flattened out late. GRANDE prompted the pace three wide, moved closer on the turn and continued well to the finish. DOUBLE DOWN VINMAN vied for the lead outside to the stretch then weakened slightly. SLATE vied for the lead inside for half a mile then faltered. DEPUTYVILLE dropped far behind early and was never a factor. WAWASET PARK raced outside and gave way after half a mile.
