**Footnotes**

TRADER HILL was settled back early, came three wide into the drive, closed well on the inside to get up late, driving. HEART IN HAND was allowed to settle early, made a four wide move entering the stretch, but was outfinished by the winner, good effort. SWEET 'N GOLDEN was in tight into the first turn, made a three wide bid to shake clear on the far turn, but faded late. RAMBO MOUNTAIN was settled back early, made a seven wide middle move on the backstretch, but flattened out. RISINGALMA was five wide into the first turn, chased the pace three wide, weakened. RINGSIDE ALICIA lacked a rally. THUNDER KAT failed to menace. SPEAK COMPELLING stalked the early pace and made a bid on the backstretch to duel for the lead, weakened. OUR SISTER GINA gave way. SUNSHINE LASSIE was not a factor.
