Footnotes

HONOR THE GENERAL raced and rallied wide and was all out to prevail. SALITROSA raced between foes, took the lead and drew clear in mid stretch, drifted out badly under left handed pressure and impeded foe in deep stretch. SALITROSA was disqualified and placed third. RHYTHM DOWN BELOW saved ground early, eased out between foes for the stretch run and then was forced out late. DON'S NELL saved ground just off the early pace, had no rally. STUTZ POWER set pace just off the rail and tired. RINGALING raced between foes while just off early pace, tired. CHERRI KNIGHT was outside and just off early pace, tired. ALWAYS CROWN ROYAL raced three wide second flight, tired.
