DELA DOLL vied briefly inside, drew away on the turn and remained clear to the finish under confident handling. DIXIE STRUT raced wide off the pace, loomed boldly in the stretch but was outfinished. SIMOOM raced wide off the pace and steadily retreated. RUN AROUND GAL was outrun early and closed well without menacing. BRIGHTEST SMILE vied outside briefly then gave way. MANSION raced inside and never threatened. MONIKER raced far back throughout. WEBERS DRIVE IN stumbled at the start, raced very wide and was outrun. NORTHERN DISCO trailed throughout.
