HOLDEM'S SUSIE B. bid to the front early and angled inside, lost the lead briefly at the quarter pole, regained the advantage and edged away. MISS ALEXANDRIA dueled outside to midstretch then gradually weakened. TRICE forced the pace early, dropped back on the turn then came again late. BILLY'S LITTLELADY was outrun early, raced very wide and closed a late gap. EXHILARATED broke a bit slowly, raced far back than passed fading rivals. OUT OF IT was never a factor. SILVERROD'S KATE trailed for half a mile then showed some late energy. BLUFF CITY MISS raced outside and retreated. VOO DOO GAL hesitated at the start, moved up outside then faded. COUNTRY PRIZE raced inside and stopped abruptly.
