Footnotes

WON MORO rallied three wide and took the lead in mid stretch and was all out. DANDY DULCE saved ground to stretch, angled out at the head of the lane and was gaining lane. PLAYMERA saved ground just off the pace, fell back slightly on the turn, came again and was gaining. ZODIAQUE rallied three wide on the turn, challenged but then flattened out. FINAL DISPERSAL dueled for command between foes, weakened. AMERICAN FIRE was between foes and just off pace, tired. ELLENSBURG raced outside and failed to menace. GUILTY GAL broke slowly and failed to threaten. TIZAGAL was off slowly and then was angled out wide, dueled for the lead and then gave up position on the turn.
