Footnotes

CITY FIRE set the pace racing well off the rail under rating hold, was roused right handed at the head of the stretch, drifted in slightly and then held on under strong handling. SOURIS had her head turned to the left just prior to the start and then broke very slowly, was outrun early, unleashed a strong rally around rivals after a half mile and closed well. LADYECHO saved ground while just off the early pace, eased off the rail near the stretch and flattened out late. RHUMB LINE raced wide while just off early pace and then tired. MY TRUSTY CAT steadied briefly between foes on the first turn and tired. LETS JUST DO IT raced wide, failed to menace. RIVER CRUISE raced wide into the first turn, dropped back steadily.
