

**PHILADELPHIA PARK - September 1, 2008 - Race 10**

STAKES Pennsylvania Derby Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$1,000 each which should accompany the nomination, \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$3,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$10,000 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2008 allowed 3 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2008, 5 lbs; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2008, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Friday, August 29, 2008. Nominations closed Monday, August 18, 2008 with 27. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

**Footnotes**

ANAK NAKAL was reserved early, launched his bid while weaving through traffic on the final turn. Bravo changed his hold on the reins and roused ANAK

NAKAL right handed near the quarter pole, he switched his whip to his left hand and eased ANAK NAKAL to the outside near mid stretch, Bravo switched back to right handed pressure again in deep stretch and ANAK NAKAL accelerated suddenly and was just up. ACAI was well off the rail while just off pace, took the lead entering lane, began to edge clear in deep stretch but then was caught in the final yards. SMOOTH AIR was well placed well off the rail, joined command three wide on the final turn, drifted out slightly in deep stretch and weakened slightly in a sharp effort. STONES RIVER was outrun early, took the overland route rallying very wide on the final turn and closed. ATONED steadied briefly racing into the first turn, raced outside while well placed and lacked a strong finish. TIZ NOW TIZ THEN was well placed out from the rail and came up empty and finished in a dead heat for sixth. TWO STEP SALSA stalked the pace two wide, took the lead briefly on the final turn and then gave way, finishing in a dead with TIZ NOW TIZ THEN. YOU AND I FOREVER was wide while never far back, challenged briefly on the final turn and then gave way. ALAAZO broke slowly and failed to menace. ONLY FOR NOW was between foes and just off the pace, tired. READY SET saved ground while well placed and had no response. NUMAANY was well placed just off the rail and tired. WISHFUL TOMCAT dueled for command just off the rail and had nothing left.
