Footnotes

TRUE TO TRADITION was allowed free rein to stay with the early leader while two deep, moved clear nearing the quarter pole then widened gradually under steady left handed insistence. HEROS REWARD rated in good position in the four path, started a drive leaving the quarter pole, came between horses in midstretch and dueled late for place. ROUSE THE CAT, slow into stride, settled back toward the inside, lacked a clear path nearing the quarter pole, eased around the waning Henry Street entering the stretch, moved to the rail soon afterward and finished well though outfinished in his effort for place. STARVINSKY, slow early, lacked room near the quarter pole then finished well in mid track. CRIMSON SUN stayed with the early pace four wide, continued to hold aim through the turn then lacked sufficient stretch response. BLUE SAILOR was shuffled back steadying inside the opening sixteenth, was roughed on the heels of Henry Street approaching the turn, angled out making contact with Hesa Big Star at that point then quickly resumed his chase while angling five wide, though leveled off in the stretch. HESA BIG STAR chased the early pace two deep, was bumped outward and into Carnacks Choice nearing the turn, checked again toward the quarter pole then weakened through the stretch. MAN OF DANGER was hustled to a slim lead off the rail, gave chase through the turn then faded steadily in the stretch. CARNACKS CHOICE showed no speed toward mid track, was bumped out entering the turn then had no rally widest. HENRY STREET chased the pace off the rail, bobbled while on the rail at the five sixteenths pole then faded through the lane.
