BAD ACTION dropped back early and angled inside, bid on the final turn and was up after a long drive. BRAVE TIGER was in a bit tight near the far turn, rallied inside, came out in the stretch causing crowding forcing Acclaimed into Black Tie Only causing the latter to clip heels and lose his rider. ACCLAIMED set a clear pace, was forced out into a rival near the eighth pole and tired. TRISTE DOBLE Q saved ground pursuing the pacesetter then gave way in the stretch. DIXIELAND COWBOY dropped back before half a mile then passed fading rivals. RANDOM STRIKE dropped back early and was finished by the final turn. Y'ER MAN raced wide and began retreating on the final turn. ONE OCEAN DRIVE chased the pacesetter for half a mile then stopped. BLACK TIE ONLY was in contention when he clipped heels and bobbed losing his rider in the stretch. Following a steward's inquiry inquiry, BRAVE TIGER was disqualified from second and placed last for interference in the stretch.
