WILLIE'S LUV dueled for command two wide, shook loose near the stretch and was clear in mid stretch and won under strong handling. PUPIL raced between foes early, was eased out wider on the final turn and was slowly gaining. PASS THE VIRTUE eased off the rail after a half mile, rallied outside on the final turn, challenged but then flattened out. NASTY SABRINA broke to the left, was outrun early, circled the final turn but was no real threat. HONORVILLE failed to menace. SMOKEUMIFYOUGOTEM saved ground, tired. ABUNDANTLY BLESSED showed little. BRONZE AUTUMN dueled for command along the deep rail and was finished leaving the backstretch. AGBAYANI was two wide and just off the early pace, stopped.
