STAKES Pennsylvania Derby Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$1,000 each which should accompany the nomination, \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$3,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$10,000 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 3 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2007, 5 lbs; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2007, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Friday, August 31, 2007. Nominations closed Saturday, August 18, 2007 with 28. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

Footnotes

TIMBER RESERVE was loaded and then backed out of the gate for an equipment adjustment, he raced out from the rail in closest pursuit of leader, split rivals entering the stretch, Castellano changed his hold of the reins leaving the three sixteenths pole and TIMBER RESERVE gamely held off XCHANGER while drifting out despite steady right handed pressure. XCHANGER raced three wide while never back, rallied outside the winner into the stretch, challenged and loomed boldly but couldn't go by while being carried out. ZANJERO was reserved early racing off the rail, launched his bid on the final turn, was blocked and forced to change course in early stretch, weaved through rivals in the stretch and finished well. SLEW'S TIZZY raced outside, made a nice around around foes on final turn but then flattened out. SAM P. saved ground, eased around tiring a tiring foe in early stretch, went back to the rail and had no rally. IMAWILDANDCRAZYGUY raced wide while never far back, faded. BWANA BULL was well placed between foes and tired. COWTOWN CAT was bit fractious gate, raced far back and never fired. MOYER'S POND showed nothing. CABLE BOY didn't break sharply but then was quickly sent to the front and set the pace just off the rail, remained a factor to the top of the stretch and stopped suddenly. GET SERIOUS failed to menace.
