MADE IN PERU, quickly clear, set the pace toward the inside, drew off with steady encouragement from the head of the lane then allowed to relax inside the sixteenth pole. TRAIN DERAILMENT chased the pace inside and was along for place just under the wire. ONE DAY SALE gave chase from off the rail then outfinished for place at the wire. I'M BROKE broke in making contact with Lord Sinatra, chased the pace in mid track then leveled off through the stretch. GIB chased the pace toward mid track, lost ground past the quarter pole and leveled off in the stretch. LORD SINATRA was bumped and stumbled at the break. BY THE PIE steadied early and never factored. SPANISH COUNTRY chased the pace outside and ran widest on the turn.
