POCKET PATCH vied for command two wide, kicked loose after taking the lead near stretch and drew away. LOOKALIKE saved ground, lacked room on the final turn, split foes in the stretch and closed well. PERUANO SMOKE raced wide while just off the pace, challenged but then gave way. SUNSHINE BERNIE was well placed just off the rail, came up empty. ALL TOGETHER saved ground dueling for command and tired. AZULYEKIT saved ground under a snug hold, eased out on the backstretch but was no factor. HARLEQUIN SKY was two wide in second flight, tired. SCHLEPROCK was two wide, bid after a half but then gave way.
