Footnotes

RIVETING rated off the pace about the three path, bid leaving the half mile pole, checked behind a closing gap at the quarter, angled four wide into the lane and dug in to get up the final strides. SWEET GINGER BROWN settled back inside, bid off the rail three wide past the three eighths pole, dug in with the advantage from the top of the stretch though was outfinished the final strides. VICTORIOUS HALO rated a long lead through the backstretch, was prompted for run into the final turn, dueled gamely from the top of the stretch and finished well. LESLY'S BACK, unhurried outside, bid four wide into the final turn, came out a path into the stretch and finished evenly. LONESOME NUN, unhurried off the rail, lacked room on the final turn then finished evenly. HLATIKULU showed no speed toward mid track, was carried out entering the stretch and finished evenly. QUEEN OF THE SCENE, just off the pace inside, had aim at the rail in the upper stretch then leveled out past the eighth pole. BILLIE B QUICK was no factor. GRACEE BABE, four wide the opening turn, gave way after half. PEGGYS RUN stumbled badly at the start and quickly lost contact.
