Footnotes

HIGHLAND GYPSY settled well back toward mid track from a sluggish start, started a drive angling eight wide through the final turn, dueled to the lead inside the eighth pole and edged clear approaching the wire. THE MAD ARTIST rated back inside, bid off the rail into the final turn, lost ground past the five sixteenths pole, entered the stretch five wide, dueled to a brief slim lead inside the eighth pole though yielded beyond the sixteenth. SOVEREIGN FUND, unhurried inside, started a drive at the rail from the top of the stretch and finished well for show. SHAKEOUTHETHUNDER rated a short lead off the rail, contested inside the final turn and held a slim advantage to midstretch before leveling off. EL TAJIN rated off the pace about the three path, started a drive toward the quarter pole and finished evenly. FORT DENMARK, off the pace in mid track, bid mildly through the lane. DEVIL APPROVED IT, off the pace outside, came through the final turn seven wide then weakened. BOOMER'S RANGER stalked the pace about the four path, contested the final turn and dueled close to midstretch before giving way. JAKE'S LION, off the pace in mid track, came through the final turn six wide and proved empty in the stretch. BERT'S TOO KINKY stalked the pace from the inside and showed no response on the final turn.
