Footnotes

MARILYN'S GUY stalked the pace three wide, moved to even terms nearing the half mile pole, reached the front three eighths away, raced clear midway on the turn then widened with steady handling. LORD KIPLING, unhurried toward mid track, bid six wide on the final turn and finished well. SENIORS PRIDE, shuffled back early, stalked the pace four wide, picked up the chase through the turn then leveled off in the stretch. FANCY RUNNER rated off the pace off the rail, eased three wide through the final turn, steadied while in tight midstretch and leveled off. WINK AT THE GIRLS came out at the start, stalked the pace from the inside, bore out under a hard left rein in the upper stretch and was not asked further. TAP TAP I WIN rated a slim lead two deep, contested off the rail through the final turn, was roughed when pinched back in the upper stretch and not urged further. After posting the inquiry, the stewards disqualified Wink At The Girls from fifth place and placed him sixth for bearing across the path of Tap Tap I Win at the top of the stretch.
