CHECK POINT settled back off the rail, closed ground in the three path through the final turn, ducked out bumping Lovely Lil at the head of the lane, dug in under a hard right hand drive to maintain control then came out again late stretch to exchange contact with that rival again while holding on for the win. LOVELY LIL settled close through the backstretch after leading the opening turn, bid three wide past the quarter pole, was bumped sharply outward and into Weeper in the upper stretch, dug in gamely in response to remain close then drifted slightly inward to exchange light late contact with the winner and outfinished to the wire. LACIE SLEW rated close toward mid track, angled around the drifting Weeper leaving the final turn, was six wide into the lane then leveled off late. WEEPER, four wide the opening turn, rated close about the four path on the backstretch, took the lead near the three eighths pole, moved clear at the quarter pole while drifting outward, was brushed lightly in the upper stretch and leveled off from there. BROKEN RULES settled back toward the outside, came seven wide on the final turn and finished evenly. ADELICATE MISS, unhurried in mid track, lacked room on the final turn. D J'S STORM rated a short lead off the rail then faded on the final turn. BRILLIANT SUNSHINE stalked the pace from the inside before fading on the final turn. SO EXPLOSIVE was through after a half mile. A stewards inquiry and subsequent claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner up, was reviewed and dismissed.
