Footnotes

FIRST COMES LOVE sprinted to a long lead, maintained a big advantage into the stretch then shortened stride and just lasted. CARLASRANGORUCKUS moved in closest pursuit of the pacesetter, made a gradual gain and just missed while finishing on even terms with GANHARVA.. GANHARVA was outrun racing outside then closed strongly in the final furlong and just missed to finish on equal terms with CARLSASRANGORUCKUS. ARTESIA was outrun early racing wide and closed a gap without threatening. CASCARINA raced inside early, angled wide on the turn and lacked a late response. FREE AT SEA moved inside on the turn and never threatened. MANHUNT raced far back early and passed fading rivals. LET HER RIDE trailed for half a mile and was never a factor. PINK GIN raced inside in the second flight and faded through the stretch. HER FLING raced close up between foes early then retreated. DIZ'N DIXIE was hard used chasing the pacesetter and stopped abruptly.
