STAKES Pennsylvania Derby Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$1,000 each which should accompany the nomination, \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$3,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$10,000 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2009 allowed 3 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2009, 5 lbs; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2009, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Friday, September 4, 2009. Nominations closed Tuesday, August 18, 2009 with 21. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

GONE ASTRAY worked his way forward while between foes under a rating hold, he rallied three wide moving into the stretch and quickly took command, Castro changed his hold on his reins and roused GONE ASTRAY sharply left handed in mid stretch and GONE ASTRAY drew off quickly to be well clear at the wire. JOIN IN THE DANCE stalked the pace two wide, remained a factor until early stretch but then was no match for the winner late. KELLY LEAK lunged and was forced out at the start, was unhurried early while saving ground, split foes while launching his bid near the stretch but then flattened out. DUKE OF MISCHIEF bobbed leaving the gate and then was jostled around soon after, recovered and was sent up to race outside and just off the pace, remained widest and tired. BUNKER HILL broke awkwardly but recovered quickly and was sent up to race outside while just off the pace and then tired. OUR EDGE gradually moved to the rail after an alert start, set pace inside under rating and then tired. DENVER broke slowly and failed to menace. ENDYMION came out leaving the gate causing some crowding, saved ground just off the pace and tired.
